Who is Camp For?

Our camp is open to any child between the ages of 6 and 14 (incoming 8th grade) years of age. Since this is a summer camp focused on building performing art skills, it is open to any and all skill levels.

Our camp can accommodate up to 150 campers. Campers will be placed into appropriate age group categories with no more than 8-10 in each age group.

Each Day at Camp

Camp each day will consist of a variety of performing arts opportunities for our campers. Camp begins each day at 10:00 am. Drop-off for camp begins between 9:45am and 10:00am with the counselors in the courtyard. Parents/Guardians must sign in and sign out their camper everyday. Lunch will be from 12:15pm-1pm. Camp will finish each day at 3:30pm outside in the courtyard of Sacred Heart. On Friday of camp we will be having an shaved ice social in the courtyard, included in your registration fee.

Campers each day....

Bring lunch, and SBSC Theatre Camp bottle with water. Must wear their SBSC Theatre Camp shirt each day. Please leave any electronic devices at home

Friday evening of camp (June 26th) will be an end of the week performance for family & friends to attend. The show will run from 6:30-8:00 in the Sacred Heart Gym.



Camp Pathways

One of the unique aspects of the SBSC Theatre Camp is that campers can participate in the type of theatre they are most interested. All campers will learn both a song and dance during the week, but some may want to focus more on acting, singing, or dancing throughout the week.

There are the two pathways offered at SBSC Theatre Camp :

Theater Arts Pathway: This pathway will focus on acting techniques, learning memorization, blocking, projection, improvisation, pantomime, script analysis and scene breakdown.

Broadway Dance/Musical Theatre Pathway: This pathway will focus on stage movement, choreography, different dance styles, techniques, vocal exercise, singing in small groups, ensemble singing, stage presence, projection, and audition music choices.

Master Class: Master Class is an opportunity for actors to get to experience what it is like to take part in a show in an accelerated amount of time. Actors will audition, be cast, memorize lines, build sets, learn blocking, and put on the performance. This is a pre-registration pathway only. Contact SBSC to check availability.
